- 1 Pair of shorts (cotton or nylon only NO see thru) MAY ONLY BE WORN IN THE CELL
- 1 long sleeve sweatshirts (May be refused due to content)
- 1 Pair of sweat pants (may be refused due to content)
- 2 Pair of shoes (can be tennis shoes or work boots, NO steel or hard toes)
- 2 CDs *MUST HAVE CD PLAYER LOGGED ON PROPRTY SHEET* NO extreme violence/obscene language

- 1 winter coat & toboggan (winter season only) may be new or gently used
- 5 Plastic coat hangers
- 1 clear plastic CD carrying case
- 1 personal, handheld CD player, CD/Radio player, or Radio with headphones *MUST BE NEW & IN THE PACKAGE * (No Adaptors)
- 1 belt

ADDITIONAL PROPERTY INFORMATION

- * Any items mailed in that are either not permitted or over the limit will not be accepted and given to the Jailer.

- 1 Pair of sweat pants (light gray only)
- 2 Pair of Tennis Shoes
- 2 CDs **MUST HAVE CD PLAYER LOGGED ON PROPERTY SHEET* No extreme violence/obscene language**
- 5 paperback books (no nudity) (puzzle books and coloring books will count as books)
- 2 magazines (no nudity) (posters, renewal cards/order forms, perfume, ect. will be removed)
- 5 photos (maximum size 5x7, computerized picture may be 8x10, NO polaroid, no nudity, alcohol, drugs, gang signs, etc.)
- *** <u>Items listed above</u> may be new or gently used (no holes). Used clothing items must be cleaned and sanitized***
