These items will be accepted for inmates housed in the Secure Jail Facility and C-Dorm

#### THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MAY BE REPLACED EVERY 6 MONTHS

- 5 paperback books (no nudity) Puzzle Books and Coloring Books will be counted as a BOOK
- 2 magazines (no nudity) (posters, renewal cards/order forms, perfume, ect. will be removed)
- 5 photos (maximum size 5x7, computerized picture may be 8x10-- NO polaroid, no nudity, alcohol, drugs, gang signs, etc.)
  \*\*\* Items listed above may be new or gently used\*\*\*

\*\*\*Inmates are NOT permitted to receive ANY property/money for another inmate\*\*\*

# THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MAY ONLY BE REPLACED WITH PRIOR APPROVAL FROM THE JAILER OR HIS DESIGNEE

1 Pair Prescription eyeglasses OR reading glasses (not tinted without prior medical approval)

1 Soft Eyeglass case (may be refused due to material for security reasons- EX. NO HARD CASES-NO METAL CLIPS)

### PERMITTED ITEMS THAT CAN BE BOUGHT OFF COMMISSARY ONLY

- 5 White plain short-sleeve t-shirts, (NO tank tops, NO writing, V-Neck for Males Only; Pockets O.K.)
- 5 Pairs of white underwear (boxers and/or briefs NO thongs) (small brand symbol OK-Ex, polo brand)
- 5 Pairs of white socks (gray/pink on toe or heel or whole bottom grey is permitted) (small brand symbol OK)
- 1 thermal underwear set (only white/beige/cream will be accepted, 100% cotton NO silk) Men and Women
- 5 white bras for women (NO underwire, NO slit for removable padding)

### ADDITIONAL PROPERTY INFORMATION

- \* All mail must have both a return name & address and the inmate's full name or it shall be refused. Mail with perfume, unknown substance(s), questionable or removable decorations/stickers on outside of envelope or letter will be returned or discarded.
- \* Any items mailed in that are either not permitted or over the limit will not be accepted and given to the Jailer.

  Items will be disposed of/discarded at the Jailer's discretion. It is the inmate's responsibility to advise friends/family of limits.
- \* Items will be removed from package by staff/deputies prior to giving to inmate.
- \* Property/Money may be left for inmates at the office during regular business hours only (closed on holidays) or mailed in.
- \* The only property permitted to be released to the public from an inmate's cell is legal mail.
- \* Inmates may only have 10 newspaper clippings in their cell at any given time. (NO full pages, articles only)
- \* Inmates are responsible for making sure they have the permitted amounts in their cell at all times.
- \* Any property mailed or brought into the facility with water damage or any unknown substance will be denied.

\*\*The final discretion on all property related issues rests with the Jailer\*\*
